2 Show your tricks to an evaluator

Demonstrate tricks in-person, or show your video in a free Facebook Spark Team (web menu: "Certified Evaluators").

3 Pay/Submit your application

Submit online and choose your swag. Your dog just earned their first trick title!

NOVICE (NTD) TRICK DOG TITLE APPLICATION

INSTRUCTIONS: Earn your NTD title by performing 15 tricks for a Certified Trick Dog Instructor, live or via video. Find a CTDI on domorewithyourdog.com. For the Novice title, tricks do not have to be perfect. Do not physically manipulate the dog into a trick. Treats and toys may be used as a lure, but on no more than 50% of the tricks. Advanced and Expert tricks count as two tricks, but only if they do not use luring.

NOVICE TRICKS

2-on/2-off	paws in a box
back up chute (5ft/2m)	paws on my arm
balance beam	paws up on an object
balance cookie on nose	peekaboo (between my legs)
bang game (smack a board)	platform jump
bar jump	rainbow ladder (trot through)
boing! (jump straight up)	ride in a wagon
bow under a magic square	ring a bell to go outside
catch a toy	roll out the carpet
come	send to pedestal (from 3ft/ 1m)
crawl	sit
disc rollers	speak (bark on cue)
down	spin circles
drop it	spinner wheel
fetch (bring it near me)	stacking (for conformation)
find the hidden treats	stand
focus (hold eye contact 6 sec.)	stay (6ft/2m, 10 sec)
front (come, sit facing you)	take it
hand signals (3 behaviors)	target disc (nose-touch)
hide and seek (find me)	target stick (nose-touch)
hoop jump	touch my hand (nose-touch)
jump over my knee	treadmill (sustained trot)
kennel up (send to crate)	tug a toy
kisses	tunnel
leave it (10 sec)	volleyball
loose leash walking (30 ft/ 9 m)	wall stand (front paws on wall)
memory game (3 baskets)	which hand holds the treat?
muffin tin game	wobble board

INTERMEDIATE TRICKS CAN ALSO BE USED

Intermediate tricks can also count toward your Novice title. Here is a partial list of popular intermediate tricks.

2-on/2-off peanut	leg weave
A-frame	mail carrier (take note to person)
balance on a block	open a door (by tugging it)
carry my bag	pick a card from a deck
close the door	platform jump with hoop
crawl tunnel	pull on a rope
disc catch	roll over
discern objects' names	shake hands
fetch-to-hand	shell game (nose at correct cup)
figure-8s through my legs	sit pretty / beg
go around	soccer (push a ball)
hand signals (6 behaviors)	stay (out-of-sight stay, 20 sec)
hold object in mouth (5 sec.)	target mark (go to mark)
jump through my circled arms	upright walking (assisted)

ADVANCED & EXPERT TRICKS COUNT AS 2 TRICKS

Advanced and Expert tricks can also count toward your Novice title. They will count as 2 tricks if performed with no luring. Here are a few popular ones.

back up on stairs	mailbox: open lid, fetch mail
balance beam: double rails	piano
bark the answer (2+2=bark)	piggybank (coin in slot)
basketball	push a shopping cart
bow	say your prayers
climb a ladder	skateboard
cornhole bean bag game	soda from the fridge
cross your paws	spin tight circle on a small block
cue cards	tap light
distance work (3 tricks, 10ft/3m)	teeter-totter
egg and spoon race	tidy up toys
footsies (paws on my feet)	treibball (push ball toward you)
heel at left side, automatic sit	wave
jump rope	weave poles
